Modernizing Water Governance

2.1... set **specific management goals** and policy objectives for Lake

Winnipeg, against which projects within the watershed can be **assessed**.

9.1. . . evaluate the current licensing regime for hydro projects and ensure that legislation and regulation is consistent with modern legislative, consultation and environmental standards.
9.2. . . require relicensing of hydro projects to be done under The Environment Act

The concern is that the innate violence of the process can send projectiles flying from the mouth of the *shredder*. *IM's response is* that, as the facility is surrounded by chain-link fence, this could not happen. They added that, if this were a legitimate concern, their employees, including the operator, could be in danger. They would not do this. – August 18, 2009 CEC Report
